



# WYNDHAM GRAND

LONDON CHELSEA HARBOUR

## Directions to the Wyndham Grand London Chelsea Harbour, SW10 0XG

### From Heathrow London Airport:

Tube: Piccadilly line to Earls Court

*Then:*

Take C3 Bus to Chelsea Harbour (entire journey c. 1hr 15mins)

*or*

Take the District line to West Brompton from where you can take the overland to Imperial Wharf (entire journey – c. 1hr 5 mins)

Taxi: 30 to 45 minutes

Chauffeur Service: Please call Concierge to arrange

### From Gatwick Airport:

Train: Train to Clapham Junction and change for train to Imperial Wharf (35-40 mins)

Taxi: 1 to 1 hr 20 minutes

Chauffeur Service: Please call Concierge to arrange

## **By Tube**

### From Earl's Court:

District line to West Brompton, from where change to overland train to Imperial Wharf (10 to 15 mins).  
Walking from Imperial Wharf station: Take the left out of the station. The Hotel is set back on the right after the Design Centre (as the road starts to curve to the left).

*or*

Take the C3 bus to the Chelsea Harbour Design Centre bus stop.

### From Fulham Broadway:

By foot:

Turn left on Fulham Rd toward Waterford Rd

Turn right onto Holmead Rd

Turn left onto King's Rd

Turn right onto Lots Rd

Continue onto Chelsea Harbour Drive and the Hotel will be in front of you.

By bus:

Take bus no.391 from stop E at Fulham Broadway towards Sand's End/Sainsbury's and get off at stop R at Imperial Wharf Station/Chelsea Harbour. The hotel is to the left of the Interior Design Centre

### From Sloane Square:

Take bus no.22 to Lots Road. Turn right and then left into Lots Road.

Walk down Lots Road until you see a small roundabout. Carry straight over the roundabout and bear left as the road bends round to the right. The hotel is straight ahead.

## **Parking**

Valet car parking service is available. Alternatively, instead of driving up to the main entrance of the hotel, follow the road round to the right and park in the NCP car park on the left. There is access to the main entrance of the hotel from inside the car park.
